

## REGION VIII SCHOLARSHIP FUND GUIDELINES

**PURPOSE:** Imperial Premium Finance, Inc., established this fund for the purpose of providing financial assistance to the Region VIII NAIW (National Association of Insurance Women, International) members who require assistance for their insurance educational endeavors. It continues with the assistance of A. Marie Yarbor and Brady, Harbord & Payne Insurance Brokers and donations from Associations in Region VIII.

**OBJECTIVE:** To promote professional insurance education among Region VIII NAIW members.

### ELIGIBILITY:

1. The applicant must be a member of NAIW Region VIII, in good standing, for at least one year prior to applying to the fund.
2. The course must be in a subject related to insurance .
3. A completed application must be signed by either the President or Education Chairperson of the local association, verifying the applicant's NAIW membership status.
4. A copy of the applicant's class/course registration form must accompany the application to the fund. Receipts for courses/books will be required.

**ADMINISTRATION:** The submissions will be reviewed as they are received. Based on the information submitted and at the discretion of the trustee, the Scholarship Funds will be dispersed.

The fund will accept donations but will not solicit them.

A limit of \$500.00 per calendar year, per recipient for scholarship funds, is applicable effective 1/1/96.
